After graduating from Sacred Heart Catholic School in 1974 she joined the United States Army. Carol served from June of 1978 thru June of 1981.

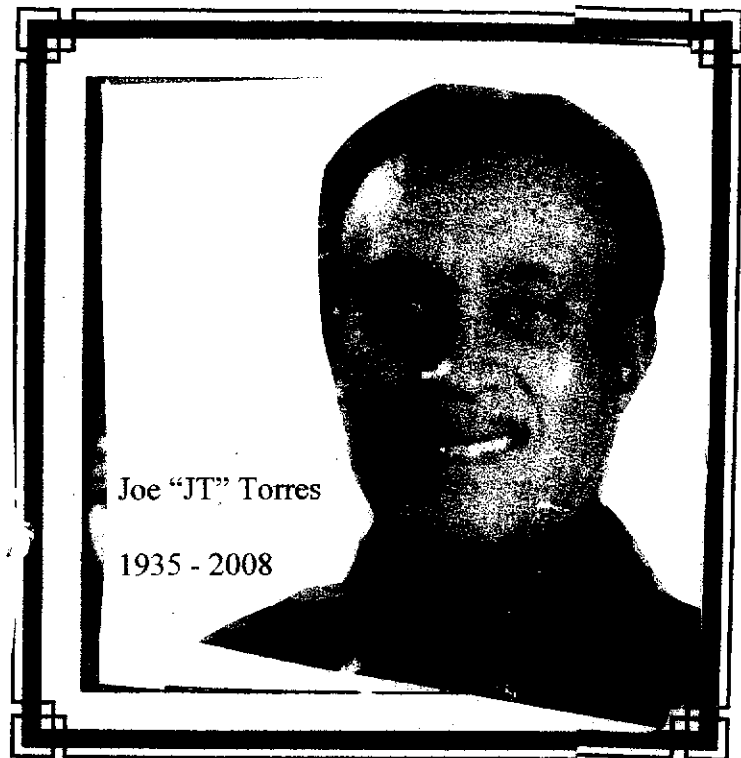
Carol met and married Charles Williams, a likeable Indian Acres Funsteader, on February 18, 2002.
