The family will receive friends from 6 to 9 p.m. Monday, Sept. 28, at the funeral home.

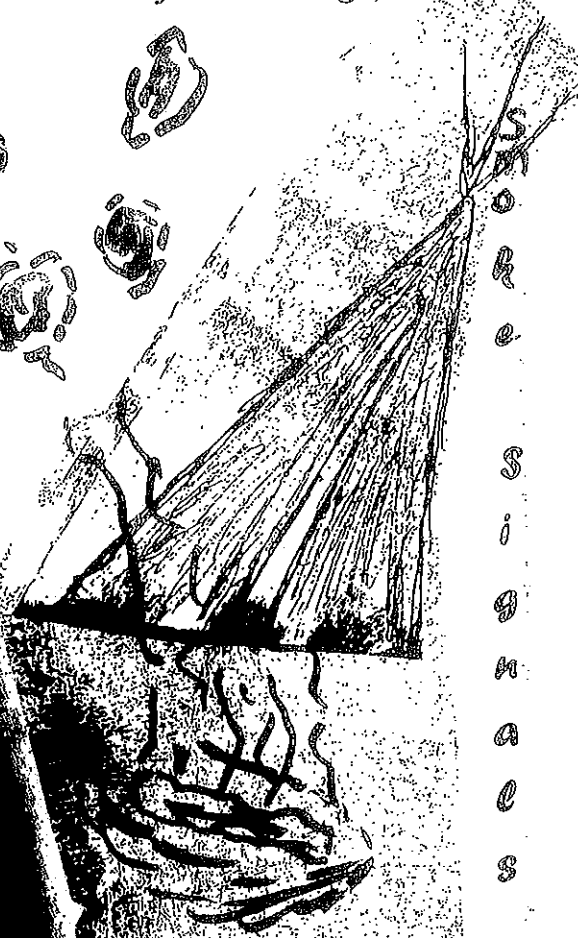
