IACT is in big preparation for the weekend's FIREWORKS Show. Thank you to everyone that will be celebrating with us. Let's all stay safe and enjoy the weekend!

IMPORTANT REMINDERS: For the preparation of the fireworks show, the main entrance and exit into IACT will CLOSE around 8pm on Saturday, July 5th to prepare for the fireworks show. Trapp Farm will be used for entering and exiting. Please let your family and guests' members know the location of Trapp Farm. ID and passes for guests are still required. The main gates will open back once the

clearance is given by the Fire Marshall. Everything within the orange fencing area (store/caravan circle/teepee/corral) must be removed/cleared out by 7pm. Any items left after 7pm will be subject to towed at the owner's expense.

Please do not park in any of the NO PARKING zones or on any asphalt driving roads, these areas could be needed for emergency situations.

POOLS: IACT has had a lot of use of the pools so far this season, especially on the weekends. Some days the pools have reached their capacity. IACT's pool capacity is based on its pool contract which is one lifeguard to 35 people. The 35 people would include anyone on the pool decking. Currently, IACT has Four (4) lifeguards with rotation on the weekdays and five (5) lifeguards with rotation on the weekends. IACT has recently requested another lifeguard for the weekends, but that request cannot be fulfilled at this time. IACT did hire a pool gate attendant for the weekends to relieve a lifeguard from doing this.

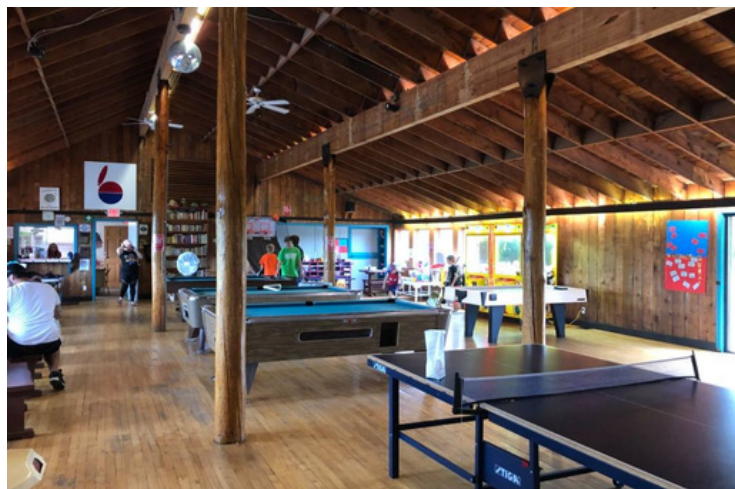
Greetings from the Recreation Department:

Whether you're navigating the winding roads of Glen 13 or circling through the roads of Glen 11, these two glens show just how different each part of our campground can feel, all within the same gates.

WOW!!! CAN'T BELIEVE ITS JULY ALREADY!!

So many questions this month about Carports. So, let's do a Site Control Department Rules and Regulations clarification this month. So, if you do not have a handbook, they are available in the office, at the gate or even on the website. The Carport Rules and Regulations did change on March 22, 2025. The new rules states on page 6 as follows:

Carport



The maximum allowable carport dimensions are 24 feet in width, 48 feet in length, and 20 feet in overall height.

When you get ready to place that carport either call or come and see us here at the Site Control Office so we can get you the necessary paperwork needed for the county and us as well. Some things to remember we need to know exactly the size that you are wanting to place on your lot. The county can take up to 2 weeks to get your permit and then you will present us with the final county permit to receive the IACT Permit so plan accordingly.

Improvements Requiring BOTH an IACT and Spotsylvania County Permit

IACT Site Control permit requirements remain the same, but County permit application requirements vary depending upon the improvement. Spotsylvania County Building Permits are available through the Spotsylvania County Code Compliance office. It is always good to check the latest regulations before starting your project. If you have any questions, they can be reached on-line or by phone at (540) 507-7222.

Debris

Also, many issues with debris not leaving IACT Property. You are responsible for your vendor the entire time that they are doing the job for you. Whether building something or cutting trees. It is your responsibility to make sure all the debris is taken off property and not placed on someone else's lot. Violation of this matter and any damages done will cause fines to be incurred until the matter is cleaned up or fixed.
