

What Time? 11:30am shortly after the Sportsman's Club meeting.

Who can Come? All are welcome, non-Sportsman's club members and guests, if you are at the acres you are invited. Kid friendly event we love our young shooters. **Youth rifles will be available for kids.**

How Much? 5 bucks' cash per shot, winner receives cash prize 70/30 split, winner gets 70% of the pot for each round.


