ON SATURDAY, APRIL 6TH AT 1 PM, THE GLEN CHIEFS WILL MEET WITH THE IACT PRESIDENT, RICH SEXTON, AND THE RECREATION DIRECTOR, CAROLYN WASHINGTON-NEWMAN, TO DECIDE WHEN WE WILL HAVE THE GOLF CART PARADES (MY FAVORITE) AND OTHER CAMPING SEASON ACTIVITIES. ON SATURDAY APRIL 13TH AT 11 AM, THE GLEN CHIEFS WILL MEET AGAIN FOR THE FIRST-OF-THE-SEASON GLEN CHIEF COUNCIL MEETING. AT THESE MEETINGS, GLEN CHIEFS CAN BRING ISSUES FROM THEIR GLEN PROPERTY OWNERS THAT CAN BE DEALT WITH AT THE GLEN CHIEF COUNCIL LEVEL OR ELEVATED TO THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS REPRESENTATIVE. WE ALSO GAB ABOUT OTHER GLEN ACTIVITIES.

ON THE WEEKEND OF APRIL 12, 13, AND 14, IACT WILL BE HAVING AN OPEN HOUSE EVENT FOR PROSPECTIVE NEW PROPERTY OWNERS. IF YOU HAVE FRIENDS, NEIGHBORS, OR RELATIVES THAT MIGHT BE INTERESTED IN BECOMING IACT MEMBERS, THIS EVENT IS A GOOD ONE FOR THEM TO ATTEND. IN ANTICIPATION OF THE OPEN HOUSE EVENT, THE GLEN 3 GLEN CHIEF, TIM WAGGETT (LOT 73), IS CALLING FOR A GLEN CLEANUP EVENT. AT AN EVENT LIKE THIS, WE USUALLY TRY TO SPRUCE UP THE COMMON AREAS IN OUR GLEN WHICH ARE AROUND THE BATHHOUSE PAVILION, AT EAGLE PARK, WHICH IS ON THE ENTRANCE ROAD FROM TONTO DRIVE, AND AT THE GLEN 3 BOAT RAMP WHICH IS ALSO THE ENTRANCE TO GLEN 3 FROM GLEN 4. THE GLEN CHIEF WILL BE UP AT THE BATHHOUSE PAVILION AT 9 AM WITH A UTILITY TRAILER, BLOWER, AND RAKE TO REMOVE ANY UNWANTED LEAVES. PARTICIPANTS CAN BRING THEIR OWN BLOWERS AND RAKES TO HELP. IF YOU HAVE BAGGED LEAVES AT YOUR LOT, WE MAY BE ABLE TO SWING BY AND GRAB THOSE TO TAKE THEM OFF-PROPERTY TO BERKELEY LANDFILL.
