I would like to personally thank all my staff members and helpers for working over and beyond for this event. Also, thanks to all our volunteer DJ's that entertained over the weekend.

The IACT lakes were recently tested for the following:
Fecal Coliform, Enterococci, Algae, Nitrates and BOD (Biochemical oxygen demand). All results were satisfactory and within the VDH regulations. IACT will continue to test monthly the beach area on Lake Pocahontas throughout our season to ensure the safety of our swimmers.

#### **REMINDERS from Security:**

**SECTION 8 –** UNDERAGE DRIVER No one under the age of 16 may operate a golf cart, fun cart/mini dune buggy, ATV, motor scooter, dirt bike, 2-, 3- or 4wheeler, or other alternative motorized vehicle at IACT.

SECTION 31 – SPEEDING / EXCESSIVE SPEED --SPEED LIMITS are 20 mph on the hard surface roads, 10 mph in the glens and 10 mph around the Caravan --Circle. --SPEED LIMIT towards the jumping pillow, Rec Center, Pools, and Clubhouse is 5 mph. --EXCESSIVE SPEED-Failure to obey a posted sign

Let's remember to have a safe and fun month. Would like to remind everyone that permits are a must. If you are moving a camper/shed etc. from one lot to another or bringing one into Indian Acres you must have a permit. Tree and Gravel permits seem to have gotten overlooked. You must have these permits to do work in IACT. Trees must be expected before any permits are issued and must have the permit in hand before any work is done on property. Yes, your contractor can pick up the permit for you but you as the property owner needs to make the call and give us the information. Then all permits must be posted on property. If they are not, it's as if you don't have a permit and can be fined.

Contractors you may call or stop by our office and verify the property owner has that permit before doing any work.

As I always say its cheaper to get the IACT permit than it is to get fined and fixed what you have already done.

I have met some amazing property owners that are really trying hard to make IACT a better place to enjoy and would like to take this opportunity to thank you for what you are doing. Many have taken the time just to walk around the Glens and pick up trash from the roadways, to offering to cut grass on an abandoned property in there Glen to even cleaning up some of those properties. I am excited to see where this year will take us and meet more of you. If this is something that you are wanting to do stop by the office and see me. As I get out to do my inspections and meeting more of our property owners remember you don't have to wait and catch me out and about you can always stop by the office.
