Stickers for 2025-2026 are now available and are required for alternate motorization


Rule Spotlight:

(For example, additional passengers on a vehicle not designed for more than the number of seats for passengers is strictly prohibited. Golf cart seats designed for 3 occupants cannot have more than 3 seated passengers.)


