Campfire Orange Cakes

Looking for something fun to try around the fire? This simple recipe lets you bake a warm, flavorful cake right inside an orange.

WHAT YOU'LL NEED

- › Oranges
- › Cake mix (just-add-water works best)
- › Aluminum foil

HOW IT WORKS

- › Cut the top off the orange and scoop out the inside
- › Fill the orange about three quarters full with cake batter
- › Place the top back on and wrap in foil
- › Set in hot coals for about 10 to 15 minutes

IMPORTANT NOTICE

Delinquent Member

A **DELINQUENT MEMBER** is any member owner who is not current in payment of any **annual charge and/or any assessments** with respect to any and all LOTS owned by the member.

A delinquent member is prohibited from using any of the amenities and/or services of the association. If a delinquent member is found at any of the amenities and/or using services of the association, that member can be ticketed by IACT Security and be charged with **criminal trespassing**.

If the electricity has been disconnected to a lot for non-payment, plugging into another location is considered **"theft of electricity"** and/or **"tampering with a riser"** and that owner can be ticketed by IACT Security and the owner could be charged with **criminal theft**.
