## S'mores Banana Boats

### WHAT YOU'LL NEED

- › Ripe bananas (one per person)
- › Mini marshmallows
- › Chocolate chips or chunks
- › Aluminum foil

- › Wrap tightly in foil and place on hot coals for 5 to 8 minutes

### RULE REMINDER

A repeat issue this period — **10 violations** recorded for Theft of Electricity, our 2nd highest violation. Please review the rule below:

### SECTION 18 — THEFT OF ELECTRICITY / TAMPERING WITH RISER / OBSTRUCTION OF RISER

“ Any attempt to bypass (or instructing another individual to attempt to bypass) the riser/breaker of any electrical riser within IACT whose electrical service has been disconnected by IACT. Also, tampering/altering of any riser/breaker on any lot for any reason by anyone not authorized by IACT will be assessed the same penalty. Chaining or locking of a riser box is prohibited. No obstruction of riser within 3 feet of riser.
