
Greetings from the Recreation Department:

CAN I LINE MY LOT WITH LOGS?

We are still seeing properties getting lined by logs. That is not allowed. If you have any around your property it needs to be removed. This is leaving debris on the lot and all debris must have been removed from the lot once the trees are cut. Also, without a survey you really don't know where your property lines are, many are guessing and then costing the owners several hundreds of dollars to have these logs removed from the neighbor's property after the vendors have already left. So, it is just as easy to remember to make sure all vendors that you have do any type of work to your property remove all debris and not leave on your or your neighbor's lot. We are also running into some vendors doing damage on the neighbor's lot. Again, this is not a vendor issue to fix this is the Property owners' issue and you will be held responsible for all damage to a neighbor's lot.

NEW OWNERS

We have gotten to meet so many new property owners over this last month. I would like to welcome them all. So many questions are coming forth about what can and cannot be done on the lots. That's what we are here for if you have questions reach out either by email or phone. We will get them answered in a timely manner.

TIPS FOR CLOSING UP CAMP

A lot of you will start closing camp. Please remember when you do your blue boy must either be fully unattached from camper and blue boy itself or must be connected at both ends. Also, it's always a good idea to clean out those culvert pipes before you leave camp to help with the drainage. You would be surprised how one clogged culvert pipe can ruin a road and your neighbor's lot, and I know none of us want to be the one at the end of that flood.

UPDATE YOUR PHONE NUMBER AND ADDRESS

Many trees have fallen this year, and it is essential that we have a correct address and phone number on file to reach you. I ask: if you have moved, or not sure what address and phone number is on file, whether you are in good standing or not, reach out to the office by email or call us and let us know to update this information. This helps us and the Security team to reach out to you if there is an emergency at your lot.

- NO SLEEVES OR SCOPES. SCREW IN CHOKES ARE ALLOWED.
- NO GUN NO PROBLEM. WE HAVE A GREAT GUN COMMUNITY. YOU CAN ASK ONE OF OUR MEMBERS AND THEY MAY LET YOU USE A GUN AND EDUCATE YOU ON THE OPERATION AND DISCHARGE OF THE FIREARM.

Rules:

Per round each shooter is assigned a shooting target number, and each number corresponds to a numbered target pole 20 yards away. There is only 1 shot allowed per round and per target, after each shooter has shot a round. The targets will be retrieved and reviewed. The winner of the round will be announced.

All shells will be furnished by the club.

The winner will be determined by a judge who will judge the closest shot to the small center red dot on the shooter's assigned target. If there is a tie the next closest shot of the tied targets will be the winner. There will be no shoot off. The decisions of the judges will be final.

Judges and assigned retrievers are the only ones past the firing line. After each round has been shot, Cold range will be called and there shall be no handling of firearms during Cold Range.

Stock 12ga shotguns only, Screw in chokes allowed No sleeves or scopes. If you do not have a gun, ask one of the club members about borrowing a gun. We have a great gun community and have no issues allowing others to use a gun. If you have never shot a shotgun before, please ask and someone will be glad to assist in helping you.

Cost per Round \$5.00 dollars

Winner per round receives a 70/30 split of the pot. If the pot is \$50.00 dollars, the winner receives \$35.00 dollars (70%) Indian Acres Sportsman Club receives the remaining \$15.00 dollars (30%).






